**SUBJECT:** Right-of-Way Acquisition for Travers Creek Bridge Replacement Project on Lincoln Avenue - Federal Project No. BRLO-5942(226)

**RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):**

**Accept Easement Deed and authorize the Chairman to execute the Right-of-Way Contract to facilitate the Travers Creek Bridge Replacement on Lincoln Avenue, Federal Project No. BRLO-5942(226), for a total monetary consideration of \$8,100.**

Approval of the recommended action will authorize the purchase of additional right-of-way required to facilitate the replacement of an existing structurally deficient two-lane bridge on Lincoln Avenue, as shown on Exhibit A. There is no Net County Cost associated with the recommended action; the Travers Creek Bridge Replacement on Lincoln Avenue project (Project) is eligible for 100% reimbursement under the Federal Highway Bridge Program. This item pertains to a location in District 4.

**ALTERNATIVE ACTION(S):**

Not approving the recommended action will result in cancellation of the project and de-obligation of the allocated Federal funding. Any funds received by the County for this project to date would require reimbursement to the Federal Highway Administration from the Road Fund.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no Net County Cost associated with the recommended action. The project is eligible for 100%

reimbursement under the Federal Highway Bridge Program. A check will be issued from Road Fund 0010, payable to the individual grantor(s) listed below. Sufficient appropriations for this project are included in the Department of Public Works and Planning - Roads Org 4510 FY 2018-19 Adopted Budget.

Listed below are the grantor(s), mailing address, amount for this parcel, and the basis of the compensation associated with the subject parcel acquisition:

- Parcel 1 (APN 373-260-27) - Ronald Robinson, Co-Trustee \$4,050 and Kathy Robinson, Co-Trustee \$4,050, 22518 E. Lincoln Avenue, Reedley, CA 93654. This payment is for a 0.075-acre bridge easement, site improvements, and severance damages to the remainder, if any.

Of the total compensation authorized pursuant to the recommended action, all \$8,100 is for a permanent bridge easement.

#### DISCUSSION:

The proposed project would allow replacement of the existing structurally deficient wooden two-lane Travers Creek Bridge on Lincoln Avenue with a new, two-lane box culvert bridge that meets current standards. The project will require work within the water channel.

Construction is anticipated to commence in the spring of 2020.
