DISCUSSION:

Staff is currently in the process of reviewing and revising APs. The following is a brief outline of recommended revisions in each AP:

AP 27 - Grant Applications

- Adds language to address the process of Board approval of retroactive submission of grant applications; and
- Adds language to include the Risk Management Division of the Human Resources Department to the review process of grant applications as applicable.

AP 53 - Appointments to and Service on Boards, Commissions, and Committees

• Adds clarifying language to where the Local Appointments List shall be posted based on a change in statute (either at the Central Library, or on the County's website).

The County Administrative Officer's Management Directives associated with AP 27 and 53 are also being updated.
