#### FISCAL IMPACT:

### **DISCUSSION:**

On August 23, 2005, your Board designated FCCAP as the County's child abuse prevention council pursuant to WIC 18980-18983. The Council's primary purpose is to coordinate the community's efforts to prevent and respond to child abuse. Functions include the provision of a forum for interagency cooperation, promotion of public awareness, encouragement of training for professionals in the prevention of child abuse, recommendations of service improvements and encouragement of community support for child abuse and neglect programs.

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The recommended action complies with WIC Section 18983.6, which requires that designated Councils provide yearly reports to the Board of Supervisors. The 2017-18 Annual Report details FCCAP's child abuse prevention efforts, collaborations and partnerships and public support and revenue received.
