9	WHEREAS, the District Attorney will have a vacant Deputy District Attorney position; and
10	WHEREAS, Esmeralda Garica has an extensive background with over twenty-four years
11	of County experience as an attorney. This experience has given her a unique understanding
12	of the District Attorney's Office and California law, with extensive knowledge in Prison Crimes
13	prosecution and conducting complex Lifer hearings; and
14	WHEREAS, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a one-hundred eighty (180) day
	separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act,
15	unless the employer's governing body finds and certifies the nature of the employment and
16	that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the one-hundred
17	eighty (180) day separation period has passed.
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors
19	hereby adopts this Resolution to hire extra-help retiree Esmeralda Garcia on an as-needed
20	basis, effective September 29, 2025, finding and certifying that the provisions of Government
21	Code section 7522.56 requiring a one-hundred eighty (180) separation period for retired
22	employees returning to employment as extra-help are not applicable to Ms. Garica, because
23	of the nature of Ms. Garcia's employment and her appointment is necessary to fill a critically-
24	needed position before 180 days has passed following the date of Ms. Garcia's retirement.
