WHEREAS, 1991 Realignment - Behavioral Health expenditures are estimated at \$1,787,219;
and

WHEREAS, the Behavioral Health Org 5630 requires an increase in appropriations and estimated
revenues in the amount of \$1,787,219; and

WHEREAS, Behavioral Health Org 5630 will receive funds as an Operating Transfer In from the
1991 Realignment - Behavioral Health Org 5245; and

WHEREAS, said monies are not included in the adopted appropriations and estimated revenues
for FY 2025-26 Behavioral Health Org 5630; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds
by a 4/5 vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is
authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2025-26 Behavioral Health Org 5630 as follows:
