\* Department requests for increase in allocation for the Deputy Sheriff classifications under Group 2 shall first replace Deputy Sheriff emergency allocations under Group 3 before further permanent allocations are added. The Deputy Sheriff emergency allocations under Group 3 shall be decreased by the number of additional allocations for the Deputy Sheriff classifications under Group 2.

\*\* These emergency allocations are effective until 503 Correctional Officer positions are filled, which would represent 24 Correctional Officer vacancies based on allocations for the Fiscal Year 2024-2025. Upon meeting that condition, no additional Deputy Sheriff vacancies pursuant to this emergency allocation shall be filled and the department shall return to the board to delete the vacant allocations. Any remaining Deputy Sheriffs whose positions are allocated on this basis at the time the condition is met shall remain in their permanent position until those positions are incorporated into the Deputy Sheriff allocations reflected in Group 2, or by attrition pursuant to the Personnel Rules.
