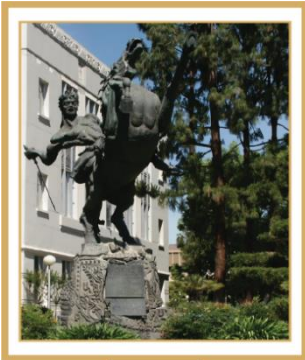


Board of Supervisors

RESOLUTION



Whereas~ annually the Department of Human Resources provides opportunities for employees to enroll in classes and courses that empower the development of skills in the areas of leadership, management, first aid, basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), safety, and wellness; and

Whereas~ on January 22, 2025, a County employee suffered a medical emergency while training was being conducted in the Fresno County Plaza Training Room; and

Whereas~ Human Resources Analyst Elizabeth Vecchio immediately placed the employee into a recovery position and monitored his vitals and Human Resources Program Manager David McCurry immediately began administering CPR upon finding that the employee was non-responsive, not breathing, and did not have a pulse; and

Whereas~ David McCurry performed CPR until Emergency Medical Services, and the Fresno City Fire Department arrived on the scene of the emergency; and

Whereas~ due to Elizabeth Vecchio and David McCurry's quick response in identifying an emergency and providing first aid, the employee regained a pulse and demonstrated signs of life by the time Emergency Medical Services and Fresno City Fire Department arrived on scene to assist and transport the employee to the hospital.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby recognize Elizabeth Vecchio and David McCurry for their selflessness and immediate response to a medical emergency suffered by a County employee, who survived.
