RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE
EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL
EMERGENCY DUE TO 2023 WINTER
STORMS

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2023, the Emergency Services Director of the County of Fresno proclaimed the existence of a local emergency due to severe winter storms, in accordance with Government Code §8630 and Fresno County Ordinance Chapter 2.44; and

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2023, the Board of Supervisors ratified said proclamation and adopted Resolution No. 23-007, thereby confirming the existence of a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, the winter storms caused significant damage to roads and public infrastructure, necessitating emergency response and recovery operations throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, under Government Code §8630(c) and County Ordinance Chapter 2.44, the Board of Supervisors is required to terminate the local emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Director has reviewed the current status of response and recovery activities and determined that conditions justifying the local emergency no longer exist;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno, State of California, that said local emergency is terminated; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the State Director of the Office of Emergency Services.
