## Code Enforcement Program Improvements

- Temporarily placed program under CAO leadership & relocated to the ISD building
- Created a new Code Enforcement Officer job description
- Hired 5 new Code Enforcement Officers & assigned to each supervisorial district
- Established new case management system
  - Reduction of outstanding unresolved cases
  - Immediate response to all new complaints
- Property clean ups & Cost recovery

## **CAO** Recommended Actions

- 1. Assign the Code Enforcement program to the CAO
  - Improved oversight & resources
  - Ensure the program remains a priority and is successful
- 2. Add 5 additional Code Enforcement Officer positions
  - Double Code Enforcement Officer staffing from 5 to 10 Officers
  - Allow for County to respond immediately to complaints and resolve issues
- 3. Add a Division Manager & Staff Analyst position
  - Code Enforcement Division Manager will provide greater oversight and leadership
  - Assist with enforcement actions and work closely with County Counsel
