Capacity & Rates Remarks

We have been outside of contract for over two years. All prices have significantly increased since the beginning of Covid, everything from medical care, food, housing costs to salaries/wages. The proposed per-diem rate, if accepted, is in line with other county jails (operating under similar capacity) within the state of California. This would be considered a fixed price and would not be subject to adjustment on the basis of the actual cost in providing the service. The per-diem rate would be fixed for a period from the effective date of the agreement and for a minimum of thirty six (36) months. Afer 36 months, if a rate increase is desired, the local government shall submit a request through Capture (IGA). All information would be provided and a new rate negotiated.

Some of these services are covered with overtime costs which has not been calculated in the Salary and Benefits. Skilled Nursing Facilities contracted with the Fresno County Sheriff's Office do not accept Medicaid rates, therefore treatment or care for Federal Incarcerated Persons at a Skilled Nursing Facilities will be the responsibility of USMS.

Healthcare Policies

Policies & Oversight Remarks

Our prisoner attempt escape occurred at our local hospital, not from our actual jail facility. The prisoner was not handcuffed to a bed and attempted to flee down the hallway but was apprehended shortly after. Our accreditation is actually NCCHC (National Commission on Correctional Health Care). We were found to be 95% in full compliance for both applicable essential standards and applicable important standards (see attachment).
This facility is inspected/reviewed twice per year by the Prison Law Office.
