A RESOLUTION OF THE PARLIER PUBLIC CEMETERY DISTRICT REQUESTING THE FRESNO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REDUCE THE NUMBER OF TRUSTEES FROM FIVE TO THREE

WHEREAS, the Parlier Public Cemetery District (the "District") Board of Trustees (the "Board") believes that the operations, management, and general oversight of the District no longer requires a five member Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that the District and the community would be better served if the Board composition included only three members instead of the current five; and

WHEREAS, the Board is the most knowledgeable legislative body concerning the operations of the District and how to best serve the community and has the best intentions and purposes in mind; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 9025 and the limitations in 9024(b), the District desires to request the Fresno County Board of Supervisors (the "County") decrease the number of members of the Board from five (5) to three (3); and

WHEREAS, the District hopes that the County approves the request based on the informed best practices the District has put in place for both cost savings and effective services provided to the community and the employees of the District.

NOW, THE BEFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Parlier Public Cemetery District:

Section 1. Board Findings The Board finds that the current composition of the Board is too burdensome on the operations of the District. The Board wishing to streamline its oversight and management of the District and sees cost savings and efficiencies in decreasing the number of trustees from five to three. Further, the District has ensured that the decrease in number of trustees will not negatively affect the ability of the Board to serve the District and the community.

Section 2. Board Requests Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 9025 and the limitations in 9024(b), the District hereby formally request the County decrease the number of members of the Board from five (5) to three (3). Within 60 days of receiving this resolution, the County shall consider the resolution at a public hearing. The County shall give notice of its hearing by publishing a notice pursuant to Section 6061 of the Government Code in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the jurisdiction of the District at least 10 days before the hearing. In addition, the County shall mail the notice at least 10 days before the hearing to the District and any other person who has filed written request for notice with the clerk of the board of supervisors. At its hearing, the County shall receive and consider any written or oral comments regarding this resolution. After receiving and considering those comments, the County may adopt a resolution that orders the decrease in the number of members of the Board. If the County adopts a resolution that orders a decrease in the number of members of the Board, the County shall designate the trustees whose office shall be eliminated at the termination of the trustee's current term of office. Any trustee whose office is designated to be eliminated shall continue to serve until his or her term expires.

Section 3. Other Items The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made an operative part of this resolution. The Chairperson of the Board shall sign this resolution, and this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption.
