RESOLUTION ADOPTING
FINDING OF CRITICAL NEED
PURSUANT TO GOVT. CODE
SECTION 7522.56 (F)(1)

WHEREAS, Supervising Surveyor, Mark Meyer, retired on March 27, 2026; and

WHEREAS, there are currently two vacancies within the Surveyor Position Group 33 in Roads - Org. 4510; however, the Department currently has an open recruitment to fill a Supervising Surveyor vacancy and will be opening another recruitment after completion at the Deputy County Surveyor level; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Meyer has an extensive background with over 33 years of experience in the field of Construction Management within the County of Fresno. This experience has given him a unique understanding of the Public Works and Planning Department, including overseeing survey projects and a vast knowledge of a variety of surveying issues that could arise on projects; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Meyer is a licensed surveyor, a qualification the department critically needs due to the limited number of licensed surveyors available in California; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body finds and certifies the nature of the employment, and that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this Resolution to hire extra-help retiree Mark Meyer on an as-needed basis, effective June 2, 2026, finding and certifying that the provisions of Government Code section 7522.56 requiring a one-hundred eighty (180) separation period for retired employees returning to employment as extra-help are not applicable to Mr. Meyer, because of the nature of Mr. Meyer's employment and his appointment is

1 necessary to fill a critically-needed position before 180 days has passed following the date of Mr. Meyer's
2 retirement.
